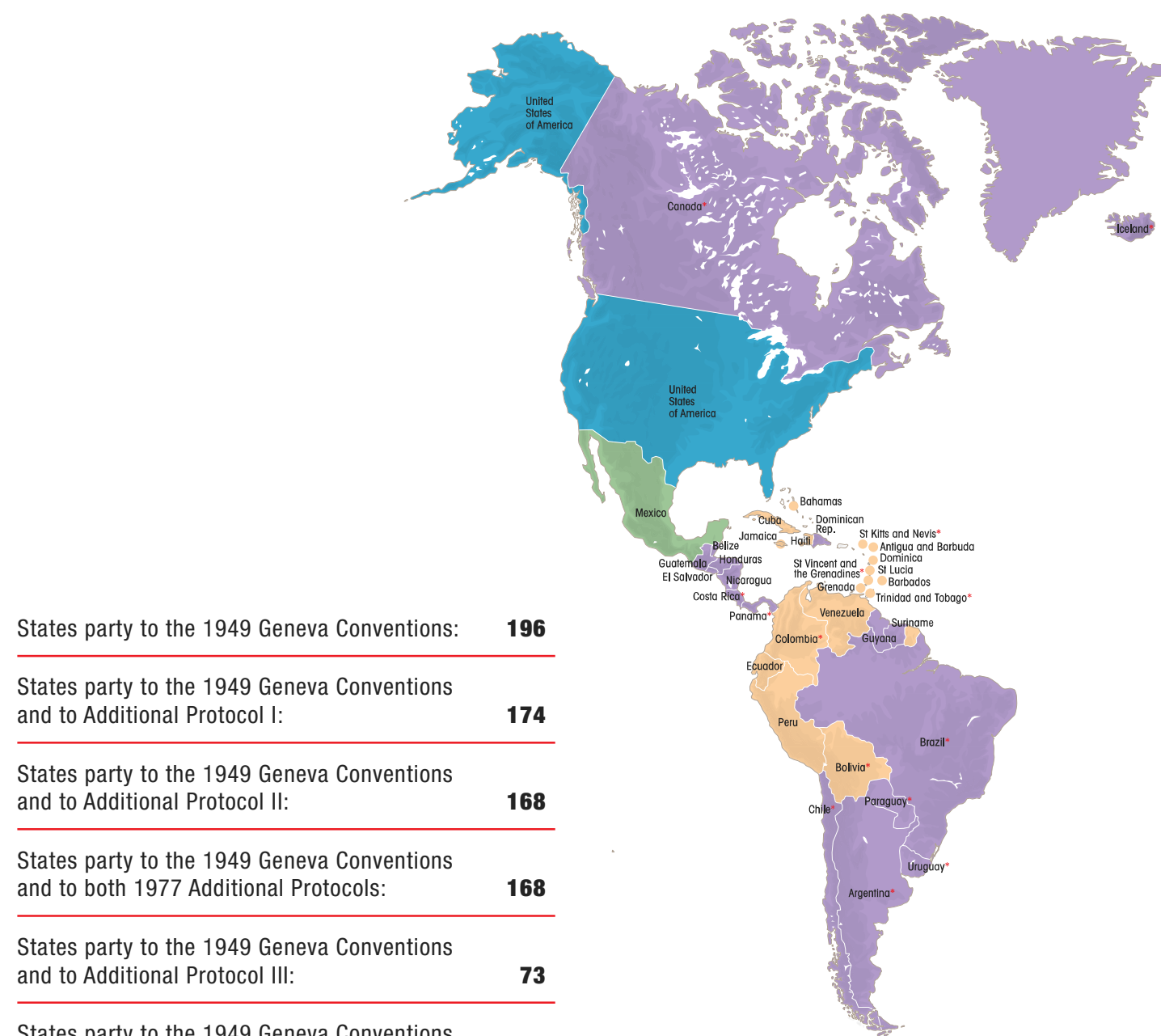
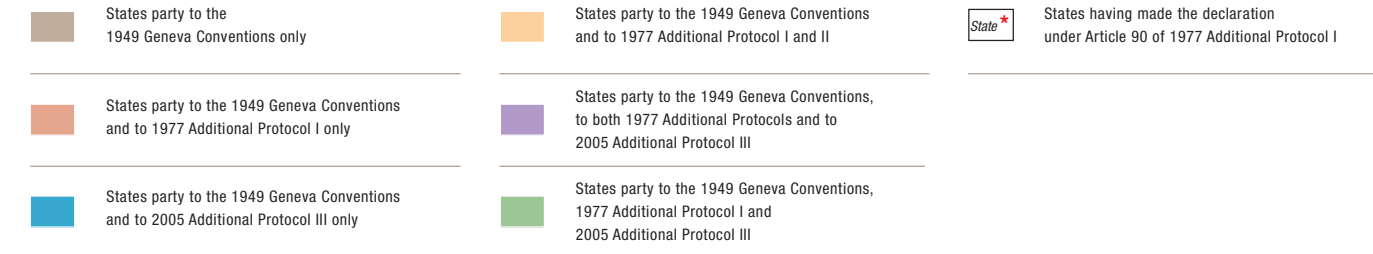


STATES PARTY TO THE GENEVA CONVENTIONS

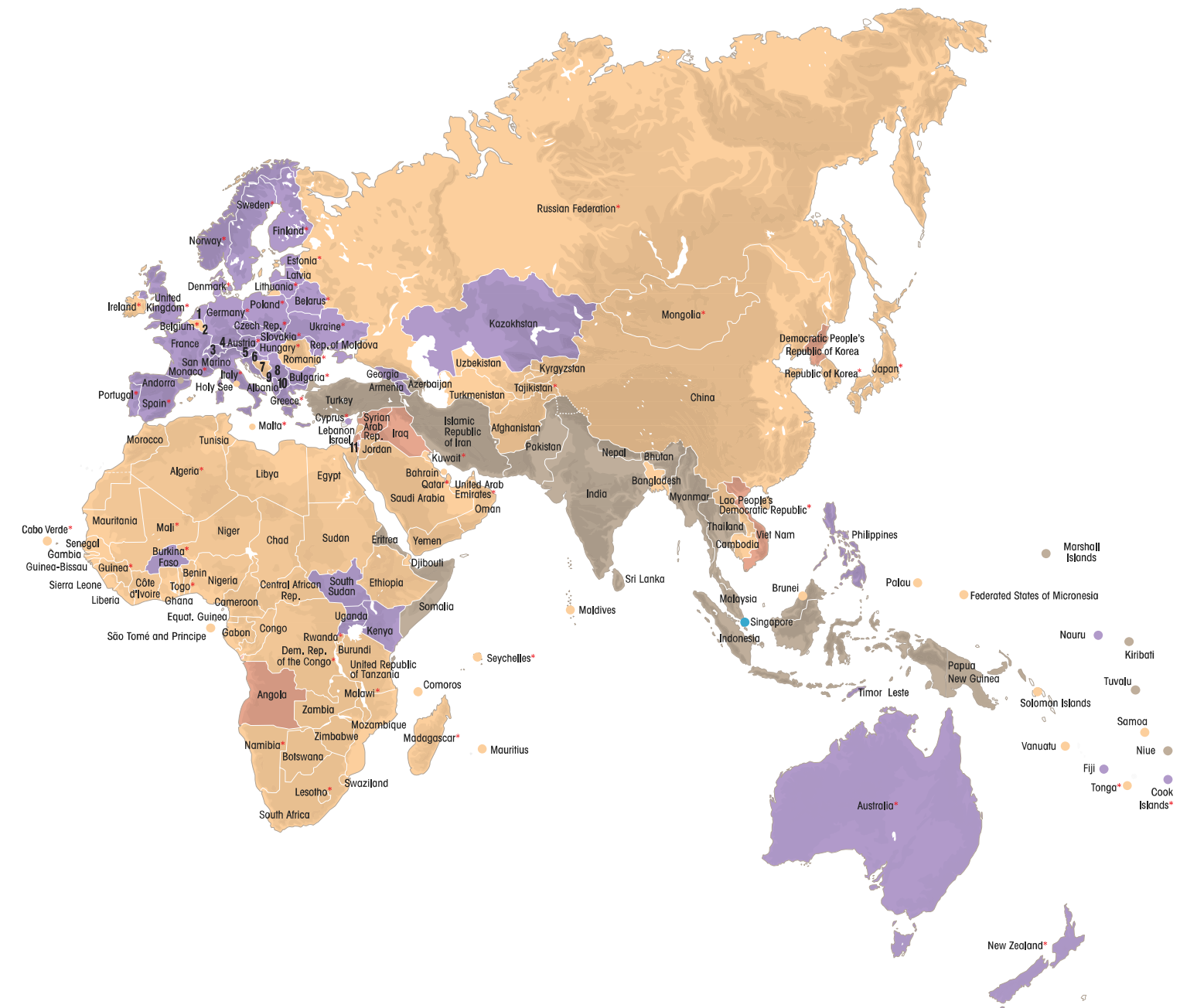
AND THEIR ADDITIONAL PROTOCOLS
